Studies show that TV watching decreases IQ and that reading increases IQ scores. We tell parents that if they want to affect their child's test scores, reading should become a priority in the home. However, it is not just reading that increases intelligence. It is also the environment in which reading occurs. A home which supports reading is one in which the parents are not yelling all the time, the TV is off, and siblings behave in a civil manner so that the reading child is able to sit and read with minimal distractions in the background. To read, a child must learn to ignore distractions. The structure of a home environment which allows and encourages reading forms the backbone of academic achievement and growth.

Even more than this, it is through reading that we tend the souls of our children, teaching them what is good, true, and beautiful. Above all, God has given us His Word. As Christians, we must be readers, for without the Word, we cannot engage the world.

With this in mind, Cornerstone encourages its families to prioritize reading. We hope you find some favorites among these offerings! These selections are just a starting point for great books for your student! Feel free to look at resources such as *Honey for Child's Heart* and *Honey for a Teen's Heart* by Gladys Hunt for more ideas.
